HELP SHAPE THE FIRST EVER ONCOLOGY NURSE NAVIGATION (ONN) CERTIFICATION PROGRAM by participating in a pilot held during the 5th Annual National Coalition of Oncology Nurse Navigators (NCONN) Conference: Setting the Course for Improved Cancer Care.

A portion of Saturday's agenda includes three specifically tailored sessions geared toward the development of a formal navigation certificate program. These sessions, focusing on the ONN Core Competencies, will include pre- and post-tests to assess knowledge gained, as well as evaluations to obtain attendee feedback. Both will then be used to update the program for development into a certified course for competency in oncology nurse navigation.

The certificate program faculty members were selected based on their knowledge and experience in the five core competency arenas. Their individual presentations will focus on their designated areas of expertise, and when combined, will comprise a comprehensive oncology course focusing on the essentials of oncology nurse navigation.

Upon completion of these pilot program sessions, participants will receive the following:

- A certificate of completion, which will recognize your involvement in this pilot program
- A 20% discount when registering for the formal certificate program developed from this pilot
- Acknowledgment of your pilot program involvement in an article to run in *Oncology Nurse Advisor*, the official journal of the National Coalition of Oncology Nurse Navigators
- 3 contact hours of nursing education credit and up to 3 Oncology Management continuing education hours for Social Workers, added to the 11 credits earned from the rest of the meeting for a total of 14 credits for the entire NCONN conference!
