Table II. Criteria for Classifying Patient as High-Risk

- Severe hypertension prior to pregnancy or at initial visit
- Requiring ≥ 2 antihypertensive drugs to control blood pressure
- Presence of target organ damage
 - Renal injury (serum creatinine $\geq 1.4 \text{ mg/dl}$)
 - · Left ventricular dysfunction
 - · Retinopathy
 - · History of stroke
- Poor compliance with medical care
- Poor outcome in previous pregnancies
 - · Perinatal death
 - · Abruptio placentae
 - · Delivery at < 34 weeks' gestation
- Secondary hypertension
